Town Council Budget 22 / 23:

The Council resolved upon a budget of £10,000.00 for Environmental projects in the current financial year.

At the Decarbonisation and Environment Committee Meeting held on 8 February 2022 Members considered the Agenda item:

"That £3,000 be provided from the Environment Budget to ACE Railway towards the cost of building the economic and environmental case to reconnect Bideford to the main rail network."

It was recommended to Council (approved and adopted) that £3,000.00 is provided from the Climate Change budget to support the Environmental aspect of the Economic Report and the benefits to the decarbonisation of Bideford.

Should the monies remain ringfenced, £7,000.00 only remains available from the current budget.
